POLICY FOR SOCIAL EVENTS/ACTIVITIES AT REGENCY AT PROVIDENCE

On Site or Off-Site Community Social Events and Activities

-) All events and activities must be open to all RAP residents.
- RAP residents who are single may bring one adult guest to events and activities.
- If the event or activity is not at capacity, it is at the sole discretion of the coordinator(s) whether or not non-residents will be permitted to participate.
- Residents must be allowed ample time to respond to the invitation sent via RAP flyer before non-residents may be included.

Scheduled Programs and Athletic Activity Exceptions

- Activities with a paid instructor: If any class run by a paid instructor is not filled by residents of RAP, a guest of a resident may join the class at the discretion of the instructor for that particular session.
- **Table tennis** is restricted to RAP residents only who must have prior instruction in setting up the table.
- **Indoor Pool:** When scheduled activities/classes are taking place, such as water aerobics and water volleyball, the indoor pool will be closed to non-participating residents and guests. The spa will remain open for use.

A guest must be accompanied by a resident if that guest is at the clubhouse, tennis courts, pool, gym, or any Regency event or activity.
