INDOOR POOL RULES

Hours: 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

- Use of the pool is for Regency at Providence residents and their guests only. No more than SIX (6) GUESTS PER HOUSEHOLD are permitted at any one time. Residents MUST always accompany their guests, both at the indoor and outdoor pools.
- The indoor pool is restricted to RESIDENTS ONLY before 10 a.m. and after 8 p.m.
- GLASS containers are NOT permitted. SMOKING is NOT permitted.
- No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed at any of the pools.
- CHILDREN who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers with snugfitting elastic waist and leg bands to prevent water contamination.
- Diving, running, jumping, ball playing, tossing children in the air while in the pool, cannonballs, and Marco Polo are not permitted. Please DO NOT stand on pool furniture.
- Personal music playing devices must be used with headphones. Electrical appliances (radio, TV, etc.) may not be placed within five (5) feet of the water.
- All chairs, lounges, tables, and surrounding area must be returned to their original location/condition when leaving pool area. All trash should be placed in bin.
- At the first sign of lightning and/or thunder, the swimming pools will be closed, and everyone must leave the pool area. This includes the indoor pool and spa.

When scheduled activities (water aerobics/water sports) take place, the indoor pool is closed to non-participating residents and guests. The spa remains open.
